Amala Institute of Medical Sciences Alumni Association, Thrissur, "AIMSAAT" was inaugurated on Wednesday, 01st December 2010. The logo and emblem were created, on 14th December 2010, after selection of the same through a competition held among the students of Amala. AIMSAT Web Site was made functional from 30th December 2010, accessible to each and every member. AIMSAT was registered on 08th June 2011, as No. R-298 of 2011, under Travancore Cochin Literary, Scientific and Charitable Societies Registration Act 12 of 1955. Consequently, a savings bank account, jointly operated by Secretary, Treasurer and Head of Office Affairs was opened in Amalanagar branch of South Indian Bank Limited, on 16-06-2011. A short film Neelambhari by Dr.Aswathi Soman, assisted by AIMSAT will be released shortly. The accounts are published on web site.

Till today, the Executive Committee had seven sittings, the first meeting on 2nd December 2010 and the last on 08th November 2014. As per bye-law, the Executive Committee is continuing as care taker.

AIMSAAT has now grown strong with 541 members. During the period after last General Body Meeting till 30-09-2015, the Association has received a sum of Rs 132634 as income, of which Rs 115000 is the membership fee, Rs 1300 is Registration fee of last General Body Meet and Rs 16334, bank interest. The savings bank account, at present, holds Rs 323142, after an expenditure of Rs 75555, used mainly to conduct the last general body meeting and related cultural programmes. An amount of Rs 1, 00,000 is deposited as fixed deposit in South Indian Bank Ltd, Amalanagar, in addition to Savings Bank deposit.

This is the annual report for the current year and I present this report before you with great pleasure. I request all of you to dedicate your services to AIMSAT, to make it stronger in the future, with multitude of activities and services to the past and present students and to others at large.
